6. Carrodegua v. P.H.Y. Corp., Superior Court, Chancery Division, Stephen Tuber of Hudson County Legal Services.

This is an alleged retaliatory eviction case in which defendant, tenants, are being evicted after having made a number of complaints regarding their apartment to the Union City Department of Health. In lieu of eviction, the landlord offered tenants the option of remaining in the apartment at an increased rental of \$130.00, as compared with the \$90.00 the tenants previously were paying. The suit was filed some months ago and was eventually settled favorably to the tenant.
