1. MIGRANT LEGISLATION INTRODUCED---A package of bills which would affect the lives of migrant workers was recently introduced in the State Legislature. Senate Bill No. 2137 would give migrant workers a reasonable right of visitation, under reasonable conditions which the operator of the migrant labor camp may establish. Assembly Bill No. 2241 would require annual registration of crew leaders of housed workers. Assembly Bill No. 2246 would require farm operators to provide potable water and sanitary facilities in fields where work is being performed. Assembly Bill No. 2260 would require the Bureau of Migrant Labor of the Department of Labor and Industry to hire Spanish-language interpreters. Assembly Bill No. 2265 would extend minimum wage coverage to employees paid on a piece-rate basis. The Farm Worker Division of Camden Regional Legal Services and the State Office of Legal Services participated in the drafting of the bills.
