School Meals for Students: If you have received or been approved for SNAP, your children are automatically eligible for school meals. Complete the application on the school or school board website.

Women Infants and Children (WIC): WIC is still open and taking applications for pregnant women, new mothers, and children up to age five. If eligible, you may be able to receive benefits the day you apply. Learn more at www.nj.gov/health/fhs/wic.
