



Are you a tenant at risk of being evicted? A low-income landlord whose tenants are behind on rent? **Legal Services may be able to help.**

The Housing and Eviction prevention and Legal assistance Project (HELP) provides representation to tenants facing potential eviction. If you are a low-income tenant who has been threatened with eviction, provided communication about an impending eviction, or have any reason to think you will be evicted, contact Legal Services.

The Housing Stability Initiative (HSI) assists tenants with docketed eviction matters, providing information, advice, help accessing rental assistance, and representation in case management conferences. Under HSI, LSNJ also assists low-income landlords with docketed eviction matters.
