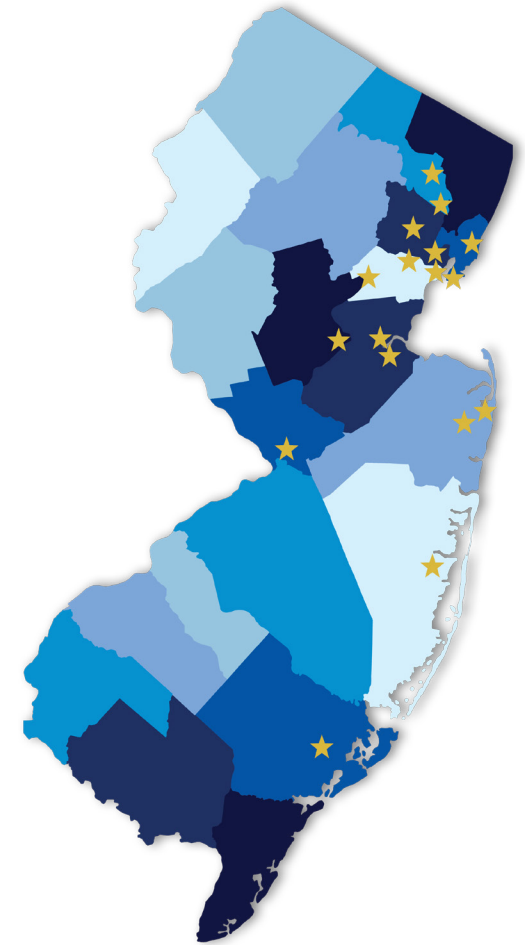
COMMON ISSUES

WHAT IS LSNJ'S LAMP PROJECT?

LAMP partners with medical facilities to provide free legal assistance to low-income patients and their families in civil legal matters. By adding lawyers to the health care team, LAMP helps to remedy underlying legal and social issues that are having a negative impact on a patient's health. Founded in 2008 as New Jersey's first medical-legal partnership, LAMP has since expanded to medical sites across the state, providing legal assistance to patients on a broad range of civil legal topics.
