WHAT IS LSNJ'S SUD PROJECT?

LSNJ and regional Legal Services programs partner with licensed Substance Use Disorder (SUD) providers, peer recovery programs, and healthcare institutions to provide legal assistance to low-income clients and their families.

By adding lawyers to the recovery support team, Legal Services hopes to build a partnership that will reduce barriers to treatment, prevent unnecessary incarceration, and promote long-term stability for individuals and families across New Jersey.

Through this statewide initiative, advocates assist individuals with destabilizing legal issues, such as housing disputes, public entitlements, family law matters, and debt collection, that too often derail recovery and community reintegration.

If you cannot speak English, we will provide an interpreter.

HOW CAN I RECEIVE SUPPORT FROM LSNJ'S SUD PROJECT?

The SUD Project partners with New Jersey Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) providers, peer recovery programs, and healthcare institutions. If you are working with one of these programs, ask your counselor to refer you to speak with someone from Legal Services.
